WHAT IS GHS ?

The Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) is an internationally agreed system of chemical classification and hazard communication through labelling and Safety Data Sheets (SDS).

The GHS is published by the United Nations, and compliance becomes mandatory in Australia on 1st January 2017. The Australian government has legislation in place, and agreed an implementation deadline of 1st January 2017 for GHS.
